



NOTHING IS ROUTINE AT THE STONEWALL RESORT IN THE STONEWALL JACKSON LAKE STATE PARK

Located in Roanoke, W.Va., near the center of the state, is one of the premier resorts in West Virginia. Built around a stocked lake and settled amidst some of the greenest forest found anywhere is the Stonewall Resort in the Stonewall Jackson Lake State Park.

Being located in a state park has the drawback—or delight, depending on how you feel about it—that the wildlife is very much in residence and very much at home in the resort. Around almost every corner are the deer, geese, and wild turkey prevalent in the area.

The recreational choices at the resort are abundant: a complimentary steamboat ride and tour of the park each evening for the guests, an indoor/outdoor swimming pool, spa and fitness center, hiking and bike trails and a catch-and-release lake offering trophy-sized bass and carp. Though this list is comprehensive, these are but a few activities the Stonewall Resort has to offer.

Five-star accommodations are located on the grounds of this unique West Virginia state park in the form of the lodge and conference center, a 2008 Pinnacle Award winner. Each room has a view, which is a welcome wake up each morning, no matter what time of year you choose to stay. In the lodge are three restaurants, the Stillwaters, TJ Muskies and Lightburns, which offers a lounge-like atmosphere complete with a delightful fireplace for warming you on cool evenings.

If you'd like to spend a day venturing to the surrounding area, near Stonewall Resort are a number of historical sites available for touring such as the Trans-Allegheny Lunatic Asylum (also called the Weston State Hospital, depending on whom you ask) in Weston, once used by both the North and the South in the Civil War. In nearby Jackson's Mill, just north of Weston, is the ancestral home of Stonewall Jackson, complete with a working gristmill, a museum, a log cabin, and tours aplenty.

 - Free use of indoor/outdoor heated pool, indoor and outdoor whirlpools, a sun deck with chaise longues, sauna, steam room and locker rooms, all situated lakeside.
 - Complimentary canoes, kayaks, paddleboards, and fishing poles (to fish on the 45-foot wooden bridge).
 - Segway Tour: Ready to learn how to ride a Segway? Tours take 75 minutes and are appropriate for any activity level. Self-pay.
 - Trail Biking: Bring your own bike or use one of the lodge's. 16+ miles of bike trails on property.
